

## **Heart After the Hurting and Broken, Part 2**

### **Matt. 9.35-38/ Mt. 25.3-40**

Intro - Remember there are four attributes of the generous man or woman. They have a heart after God, a heart after the kingdom, a heart for the hurting and a heart that acts!

After so much discussion about the kingdom, I wanted to at least share a few kingdom principles with you from Gods word. They are always in opposition of the world's ideals and are always spoken clearly by the King of the kingdom.

### **Kingdom principles**

Love - Mt. 5.44 Enemies Mt. 22.37-39 God and neighbors

Forgiveness - Mt. 18.21,22

Humility - Mt.18.1-4

Giving - Mt. 13.43-45 You give all for the treasure or the pearl!

How do you develop a heart after the hurting? Jesus placement of those who had that heart on one side and those who didn't on the other sends a message. If you are truly born again you will have His heart. While it may be undeveloped it is there.

Because we spend so much time "licking our own wounds," we tend to have a greater heart for ourselves than anyone else.

### **1. Jesus had a heart for those who had the least!**

- Zaccheus, chief sinner. Lk.19

Everyone that's broken ain't broke! Because we have never been rich or close to someone who was we tend to have flawed ideas about the wealthy!

- Insane man Mark 5.1-5

Emotionally broken is a prevailing issue today even with all the meds available!

- Syrophenician or Caananite woman. Mt. 15.22

Even then people were broken because their kids were broken.

**2. Jesus commanded us to reach out to the same people! Mt. 25.45**

- You become sheep in the kingdom based on who you help

Who you are is determined by what you do not what you say!

- You do it for them you do it for me

When you do it for them it is equivalent to doing it for Christ!

- You honor the King of the kingdom!

**3. Jesus promised to reward kingdom people with a heart for the hurting!**

Hungry - people who don't have enough food

Thirsty - people who have unquenched thirst

Homeless and alone - they have no friends

Imprisoned - trapped in a limited existence

Naked - uncovered

Sick - physically struggling
